We support blues venues and blues artists through our promotional efforts and participation in blues-related activities and events by encouraging our community to appreciate the historical value and the enjoyment of blues music. SABS hosts jam sessions, local and national groups in concert, and we participate in local community events throughout the year.

Eligibility Requirements for Scholarships

- Must prove enrollment in an academic program at Angelo State University or Howard College (at least 9 semester credit hours).
- Must have a sponsor: and applicant must complete the Application.
- Must have a particular interest in blues music that has been previously demonstrated.

Scholarship Awards for 2019-20

In the past we have had at least 4 levels of awards. Because of the success of past festivals, during the past two years we have been able to award more than 4 levels of awards. All awards require participation in the awards presentation meeting (usually in October), the Blues Festival in May, and one meeting or event. Higher level of awards also require a presentation in words or music at a general Blues meeting. This presentation should be on Blues music.
